# CHARLOTTE'S WEB



## Auditions for The Christmas Foundling

Our holiday production this year will be "The Christmas Foundling" by Norman Allen and sponsored by the Volcano Communications Group.

This script, written specifically for Sierra Repertory Theater, is perfectly suited for our Gold Country, as the setting is a miner's cabin during the gold rush, where a baby boy is orphaned on Christmas Eve in 1850. The two miners who live in the cabin raise the child until, ten years later, a relation of the child's shows up on the doorstep to claim him.

"Inspired by the stories of Bret Harte, "The Christmas Foundling" is a heartwarming holiday tale with the love of a child at its center and an unlikely romance as its driving force", says the publisher, Playscripts.

Tom is the orphan of unknown parentage; 10 years of age.


Aunt Sarah is in her 30ies, New England raised, educated and principled and seeking her lost sister.
